

A.I.S. HAGER/DuBOSE RESEARCH LIBRARY REPORT

FALL 2018

The normal quantity of Regional, Section, local Bulletins and Newsletters have been received, recorded and filed.

As indicated in my last report the library has acquired new and larger quarters. While the process of putting all documents and files in their proper place has not been completed substantial progress has been accomplished.

Donations of slides to the library has continued. The most recent gift to the library, of 450 plus slides came from a member in Virginia. Also included with the slides was an excellent copy of Maerz and Paul which the library did not have.

Filing cabinets have been newly labeled using a Brothers labeler to replace the masking tape previously used.

Progress continues in the digitizing of the Larry Harder slide collection. The 60's and 70's have been completed and shipment of the 80 & 81 slides has been made. The digitizing will continue through the 90's and into the 2000's in tune with Janet Smith's schedule. It should be noted that by the time the work on the slides at hand has been completed the quantity digitized should be about 50,000 plus.

A project that I am hoping to begin is the unifying the registration forms folders. At present the folders are a mish-mash of colors and types. These have been relabeled with the Brothers machine.

One final note...the librarian would like to express his personal thanks to Nancy Price for her donation of 5 multi-shelved filing cabinets.
