## Secretary Report Spring 2019

Due to the recent teleconference meetings, there have been no electronic motions submitted.

As respects the proposed by-law changes that were sent to members the following is reported.

Total number of ballots received: 375

Proposed change to Article 11- Purposes – 370 yes votes – 5 no votes

Proposed change to Article 111 – Membership – 345 yes votes – 30 no votes

Proposed change to Article 1V – Meetings – 373 yes votes – 2 no votes

Proposed change to Article V11 – Officers – 350 yes votes – 25 no votes

Proposed change to Article X – Amendments – 368 yes votes – 7 no votes

## Based on the votes received ALL proposed changes to the by-laws have passed.
