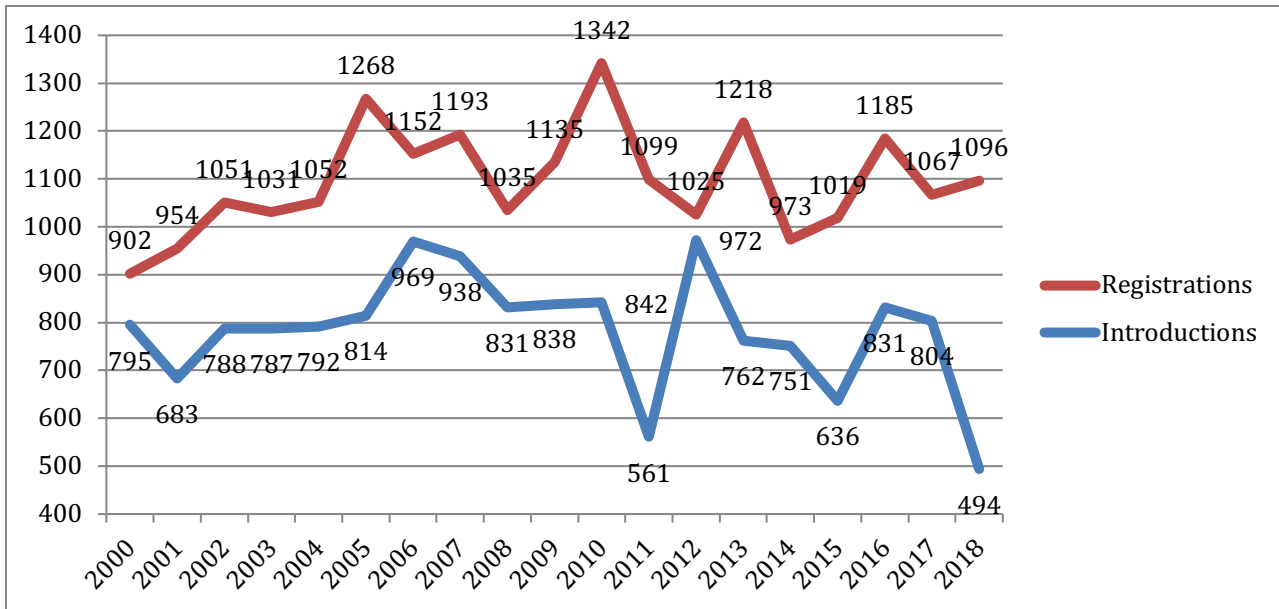

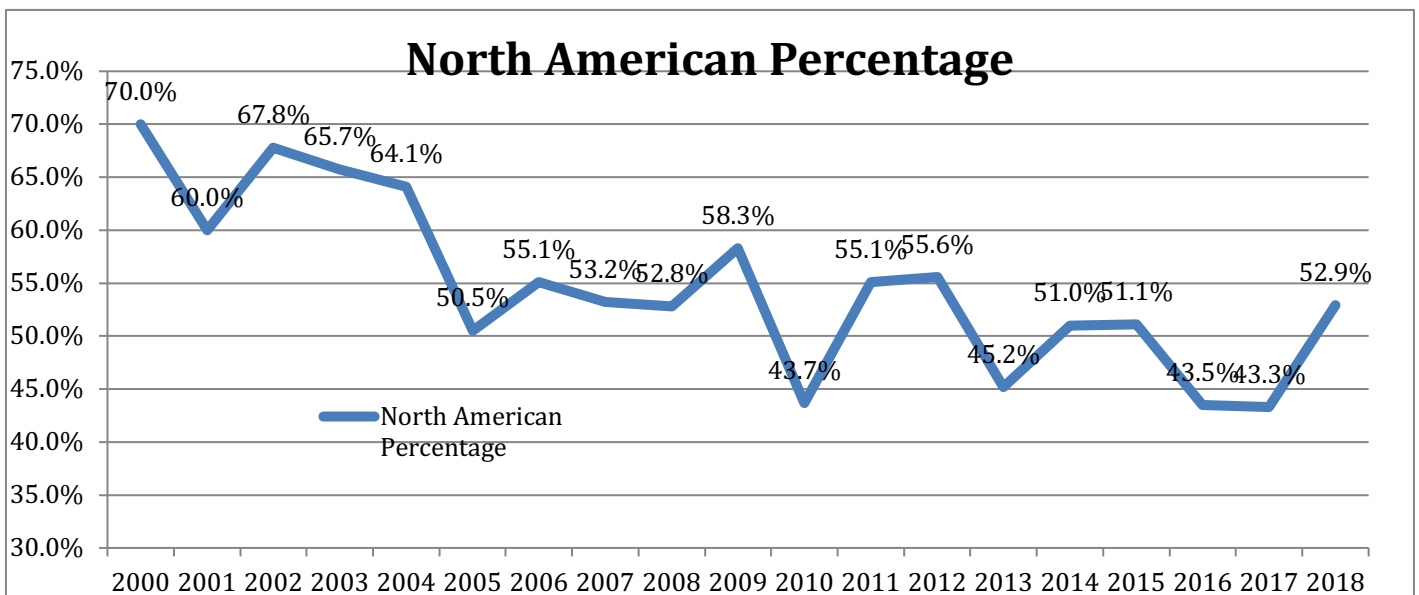
### 2018 Registrations and Introductions

The 2018 Registrations and Introductions booklet was received by the AIS Storefront on July 30, 2019

Of the 1096 new registrations, 58.7% are tall bearded, 26.1% other bearded types, and 15.2% beardless and species or species hybrids. Totals by class are as follows:

In addition, introductory data is included for 494 varieties including: 1 introduced in 2011, 2 introduced in 2015, and 22 introduced in 2017, none of which were previously included in an annual Registrations and Introductions publication.
