Rhizomes for US winners are being sent to me. I have contacted Australia Iris Society and Middle European Iris Society for help getting rhizomes to those winners.

Things that worked:

- 1. Even with late start we got many entries (42) and plenty of photos to work from (184).
- 2. A great number of the photos were exceptional making photos to be used for the AIS Calendar, book marks and other used easily able to cover.
- 3. Using a blind numbering system, we can be assured that the photos are chosen for their quality and no other reason similar to an Iris Show
- 4. Using the Web Page approach, it freed up email account and allowed for quicker review of the pictures.
- 5. By putting the Photo Contest out on News and Notes and having the entry on the AIS Website we reached many and can do better by using the same scenario.

Things that did not work:

- 1. The Contest started too late.
- 2. Not everyone could use the PDF form and many could not use fillable feature.
- 3. Most people could not send appropriate picture size:
 - a. Most (90%) people who submitted did so with raw files 45" X 50" or greater with low PPI at 72 px/in
 - b. 5% of the entrants had 8' X 10" but also at 72 px/in
 - c. 5% had 6" X 4" or less at 300 px/in.
 - d. All pictures were normalized before judging by making the smallest edge 8" and all at 300 px/in. This made for perfect viewing for judges. No cropping or other corrections were made
- 4. We don't have a way to deal with winners from other nations.

Recommendations:

- 1. Put Photo Contest rules and entry form in 1st Irises of the year
- 2. In Future allow the person submitting to crop as they want and send resulting files at one to two per e-mail and allow the pictures to be cared for by the Photo Contest Coordinator.

- a. The coordinator will normalize all photos to as close to 8" X 10" at 300 px/inch
- 3. Move persons from category 3 to category 6, It should not be about people but irises since very few entries were made
 - a. If this category is not removed, I suggest it be re-identified from "Photo of person or people at an event or tours with Irises" to "People with Irises"
- 4. In the directions the entrants should be allowed to add additional photos if their limit of six entries has not been reached with the submission of a new entry form to add to the original form.
- 5. Entrants need to be notified that all changes can only be made with the submission of a corrected entry form.
