**AIS INSURANCE**  
**SPRING 2020 REPORT**

Last fall I had advised that Insurance Company had conducted an audit for the 2018-2019 policy period and had deemed the AIS owed an additional payment of over \$4,000. I refused to pay this amount and requested a copy of the documentation which they based their request on.

After receiving the information, I noted the company auditor had inadvertently showed six conventions a year rather than one. I immediately contacted our broker who went back to the carrier to straighten this out. As it turned out the broker had not caught this error previously, though the amount that had been requested was substantially less.

In March, the AIS received a check in the amount of 4,563.00 for errors in past audits. This amount was deposited and earmarked for the insurance account.

Everything else is fine.
