2005/2006 Increased Dues \$

Since last year at this time we have some good news and some bad news. First the good news. As a result of the increase in dues effective April 1, 2005 there has been an increase in dues receipts of approximately \$24,102. This is compared to what we would have received had the increase not taken place. Also the Annual to Triennial Upgrade offer has seen a 6% return rate thus far as shown in the chart to the left. We have also seen a decrease in the number of Life Members as shown in the chart above, however with half the year yet before us my expectation is for a net increase of 4 to 485 Life Members. The bad news is that we continue to lose members at about the same rate as in the last several years. A separate report will cover ways to stop the bleeding.
