CONSOLIDATED EXHIBITIONS REPORT November 6, 2010

Supply Report by Susan Boyce

The 2010 exhibitions supply ordering went smoothly with just over 100 packages mailed out.

In September I added together all of the orders I received for the ribbons, rosettes, and entry cards for 2010. I also did inventory on the remaining stock of supplies. After figuring out how many of each item was ordered and how many of each item was left, an order was placed for the ribbons and rosettes needed for the 2011 exhibitions year. By ordering several months in advance, I was able to obtain a 10% discount – a savings of \$244.10. The exhibition supplies will be received well before the 2011 exhibition supply ordering season starts.

The motions passed at the Spring 2010 Board meeting concerning the exhibitions price increases and the adding of a shipping and handling fee, have been added and implemented on the order form for the 2011 exhibitions year.

Show Schedules Report by Lois Rose

For the 2010 Show season, I approved a total of 155 shows, including four fall rebloom shows. I received notice of one show being canceled, and two shows being reduced to non-AIS sanctioned exhibitions only. Other cancelation notices may have gone to Ray and Karen Jones. I have revised the Show Supply Order Form for 2011 to reflect the increased cost for entry tags and large purple rosettes and to include a \$10 shipping and handling charge.

Show Reports by Karen & Ray Jones

There are three more shows scheduled to be held to complete the 2010 Exhibition year. So far we have reports form 141 Shows and 37 Youth Shows. Based on these shows, 111 EC's have been issued. 23 Educational Exhibits and 2 Commercial Exhibits earned Bronze Medals. Spring 2010 show reports are still coming in. Dusky Challenger currently leads as the Multiple Best Specimen Winner with 4 wins.

For budgeting purposes we have about 120 Silver and Bronze medals in our inventory going into 2011. At some time this next year an order for additional medals will need to be made.
