

AIS RVP Representative Report – Fall 2010

RVP REPRESENTATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To act as representative and spokesperson on the AIS Board of Directors for one year on behalf of the RVP Board of Counselors which is made up of the 22 AIS Regional Vice Presidents holding office during that one year period of the RVP Reps term. The term for an RVP Representative begins following the annual spring meeting and ends the next year following the annual spring meeting.
