April 15, 2010: 560 Official AIS 2010 Ballots were mailed to eligible voting judges.

The break down is as follows:

- 222 Master

 - 18 Overseas Judges
- ooided Ballots were mailed to Apprentice judges.

Of the total 620 total Ballots mailed, 587 were mailed to United States addresses, 15 to Canada and 18 to overseas addresses.
