Since my last update from AISMemSec there have been a few changes, but overall I am happy to report that the AIS Youth membership is growing once again. We are currently at approximately 232 members. There are three active CIPs, the most recent addition is 20 members of the American Heritage Girls in Region 18, recruited by Jean Morris.
