

## **AIS RESEARCH LIBRARY REPORT**

**FALL 2013**

The normal quantity of Regional, Section, Local Bulletins and Newsletters have been received, recorded and placed on file.

In coordination with Janet Smith, Slides Coordinator, work is in progress to confirm the identity of approximately 4600 slides donated to the Library by the estates of Doug Goodnight, Glenn Corlew and Lloyd Zurbrigg. The Iris Register has been useful in providing hybridizer and date of introduction. In cases of doubt the R & I description has been invaluable. For the seedlings with no hybridizer indicated, searching the annual convention booklets for the year the slides were processed should provide missing information. Labels for the Goodnight and Corlew slides have been printed and will be attached over the winter. Labels for the Zurbrigg slides will be completed in the near future.

Again, in coordination with Janet Smith, work continues on the proof reading of the AIS Bulletin Index. Several individuals did the original compilation and as a result the final product is not uniform in several instances. Additionally, the content of assorted Bulletins from Oct. 1942 to July 1991, April, July, Oct. 2002, Oct. 2003 to July 2006 and Jan. 2007 to April 2009 is absent and will be placed in the Index in their proper sequence.

Photographs of various iris hybridizers who also hybridized hemerocallis was provided to Artur Jasinski, of Poland for a project on which he is working. Credit for the photos will be given to AIS.
