The normal quantity of Regional, Section, Local Bulletins, and Newsletters have been received, recorded and placed on file.

The library has received additional material in these past few months, most notably a large donation from Cooley's Gardens. Since the library has insufficient space, at this time, the boxes containing R&Is (2000-2008), 10 year check lists (1929-1999), catalogs, Bulletins, etc. reside in my living room. There are registration cards for iris introduced by Cooley's other than those by Rick Ernst. Those registration cards will be placed in the Bio file of each individual.

Many thanks go to Riley Probst for the delivery of Jim Gibson's 11 assorted cups and two silver plates awarded by Concorso Internazionale (Premio Firenze) held by the Sutton family. Time has taken its toll and all are in various stages of tarnish and many are in disconnected condition and will need to be repaired and tarnish removed.

Additional slides have been added to the library's collection; 200 from Hager, 540 from Figge, John Weiler (?) and Paul Black. The Weiler and Black slides are sufficiently large as to require multiple 3" binders per each.

The Cooley Collection has been inventoried with the exception of Box #8 which contains 35 mm, 2¼ x 2¼ and 5 x 7 slides.
