Affiliation Process

4. Non-Profit status

I did forward the list of all clubs that the Treasurer files under the AIS umbrella. Another short article about how to file for 501(c)3 status would be great.

5. On-line judges training.

There is an Ethics course available on disc, but most members are no aware of it. Could there be more done this way?

We would be wise to remember that there can be iris clubs without AIS, but there can be no AIS without clubs.
