

EXHIBITIONS REPORT – SPRING 2017

SCHEDULES:

As of this writing (May 9, 2017), I have approved 128 shows for the 2017 show season. I don't anticipate receipt of many more approval requests for spring shows, but there should be the usual 2 fall shows, for an estimated total number of shows slightly under last year's 135.

SUPPLIES:

As of May 13th, I have received 67 orders for a total of \$6,663. I expect to receive about 10-12 more orders before the end of June.

I have received the new catalog from which we order the ribbons and rosettes and the prices have increased and we will need to slightly raise the prices for next year. The ribbons and small rosettes were last increased in 2012 and the large rosettes were last increased in 2010. Therefore:

I move that we increase the prices of the ribbons to \$12 for a pack of 25, that we increase the price of the large rosettes to \$8 each, and that we increase the price of the small rosettes to \$7 each, effective Jan 1, 2018.
