Prof. Carol Wilson received her Ph.D. in the Department of Integrative Biology, University of California, Berkeley where she researched evolution of the Pacific Coast Iris and then completed Postdoctoral research on haustoria in African mistletoe in the family Loranthaceae, a project based at the Royal Botanical Gardens, Kew and the University of Utah, Salt Lake City. After faculty positions at Portland State University and Claremont Graduate University, she returned to the University of California, Berkeley as a research scientist, where she continues her work on *Iris* and mistletoe.
